

GDPR Information Clause for Swine Farmers

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), please be advised as follows:

1. Data Controller

The controller of your personal data is Gobarto Hodowca Sp. z o.o., with its registered office at Wspólna 70, 00-687 Warsaw, Poland (hereinafter referred to as the "Controller").

2. Contact Information

3. Purposes and Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

Your personal data will be processed for the following purposes:

 The conclusion and performance of the contract to which you are a party, or taking steps at your request prior to entering into such a contract

[Legal basis: Article 6(1)(b) GDPR];

b) Compliance with the Controller's legal obligations (e.g., arising from tax or accounting regulations)

[Legal basis: Article 6(1)(c) GDPR];

Legitimate interests pursued by the Controller for the purposes of establishing, securing,
pursuing, or defending against potential claims

[Legal basis: Article 6(1)(f) GDPR].

4. Rights of the Data Subject

As a data subject, you have the following rights regarding your personal data:



- Right to access your personal data, including confirmation of whether the Controller is processing it, details about such processing, and the right to receive a copy of your data (the first copy is provided free of charge);
- 2) Right to rectification or completion of inaccurate or incomplete personal data;
- 3) Right to request erasure of personal data;
- 4) Right to request restriction of processing of personal data;
- 5) Right to object to the processing of personal data;
- 6) Right to data portability, i.e., to receive the data provided to the Controller and transmit it to another controller, where technically feasible;
- 7) Right to object at any time to the processing of personal data;
- 8) Right to lodge a complaint with the Polish supervisory authority, i.e., the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO), by writing to Urząd Ochrony Danych Osobowych, Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw, Poland, or electronically via the UODO Electronic Inbox, following the instructions available at: www.uodo.gov.pl.

5. Data Retention Period

Personal data will be processed and stored for the entire duration of the contract, and thereafter for as long as necessary to establish, secure, pursue, or defend any potential claims, as well as to comply with any legal obligations of the Controller (e.g., those arising from tax or accounting regulations).

6. Recipients of Personal Data

Your personal data may be shared with:

- 1) Entities authorized by law to process the data, including public authorities;
- 2) Entities supporting the Controller in exercising its rights and obligations and in service provision, including providers of transport, legal, archiving, postal, and courier services; providers of security services for persons and property; advisory service providers; as well as banks, debt collection agencies, and companies providing IT services or solutions, including system maintenance, assistance, and technical support for IT systems in which your data is processed.



7. Transfer of Personal Data to Third Countries

The Controller does not intend to transfer personal data outside the European Economic Area (EEA, comprising EU member states, Norway, Iceland, and Liechtenstein). However, if such a transfer becomes necessary, it will be carried out in compliance with GDPR safeguards, ensuring an appropriate level of data protection.

8. Voluntary Provision of Data

Providing personal data is voluntary; however, it is required for entering into and performing the contract.
